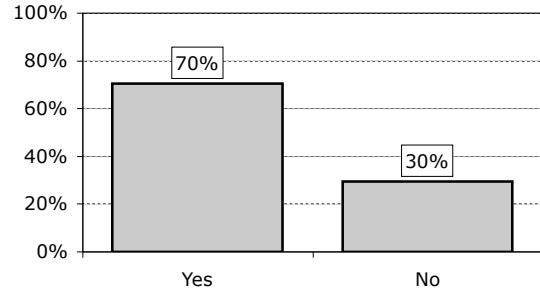

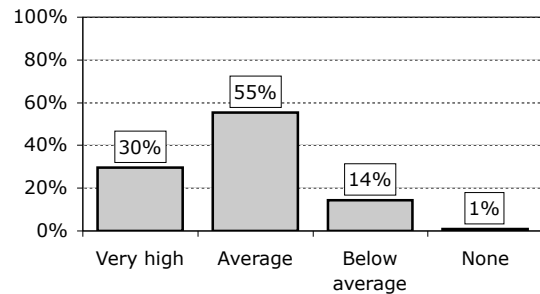
1. Is this the first class in which you have used a course website?

Valid Responses	132	100%



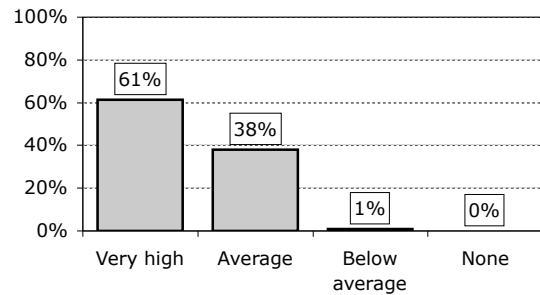
2. When you entered this class, what was your comfort/skill level with using a computer?

3. After completing this course, what is your comfort/skill level in using a computer?

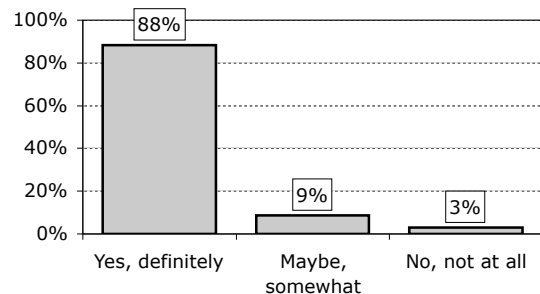
Reponse	Number	Percentage

Note: Of the 132 students responding to both questions 2 and 3, 63 (or 48%) reported an increase in their comfort/skill level in using a computer.

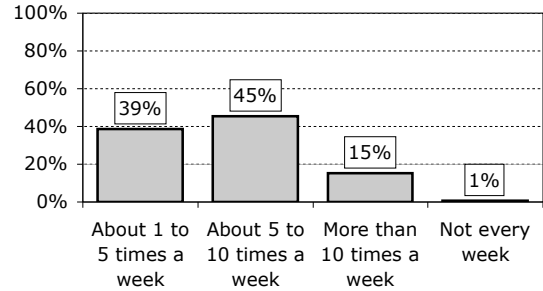
4. In the future, will you feel more secure if you take a class that uses a course website?

Valid Responses	104	100%



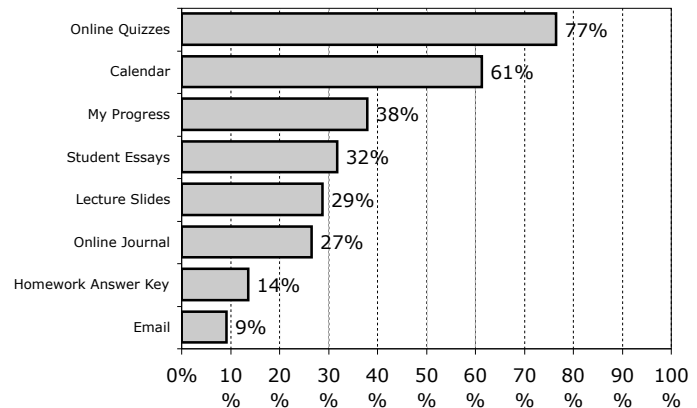
5. On the average, how often did you visit the class website?

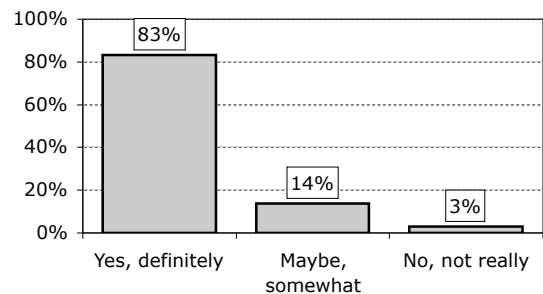
6. Which three features of the website were most valuable in helping you learn the materials necessary to succeed in this class?

Email	9%



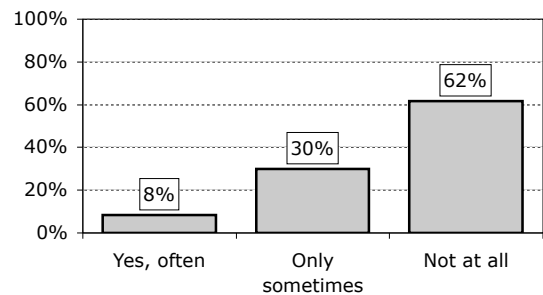
7. Did the technology help you learn the course materials better?

Valid Responses	132	100%



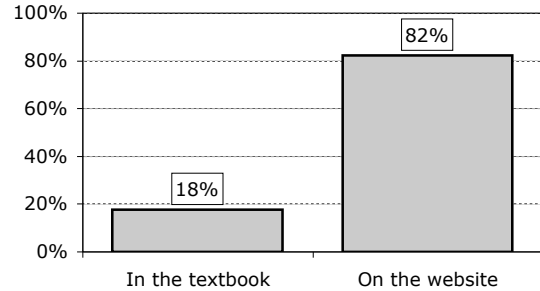
8. Did using computer/web technology in the course ever put you at a disadvantage?

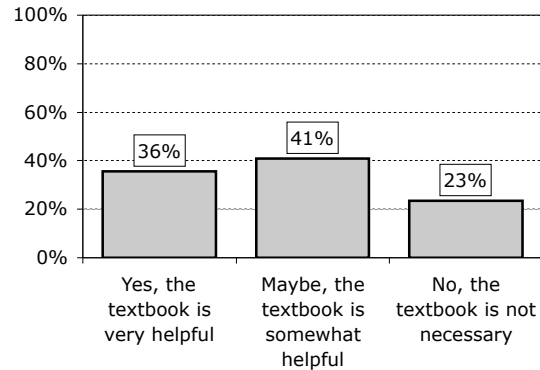
9. Did you prefer doing exercises in the textbook or on the website?

Valid Responses	96	100%



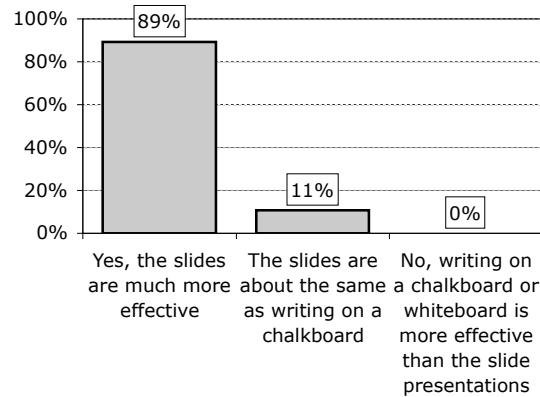
10. With all the materials on the website, do you feel the class still needs a textbook?

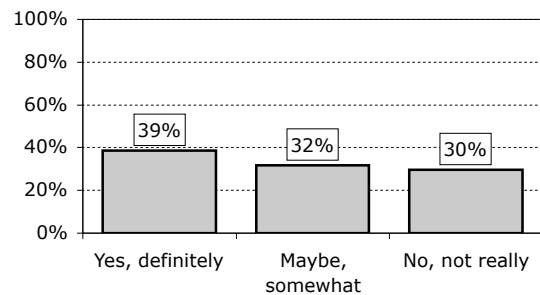
11. Do you think the slide presentations were more effective than writing on a chalkboard or whiteboard?

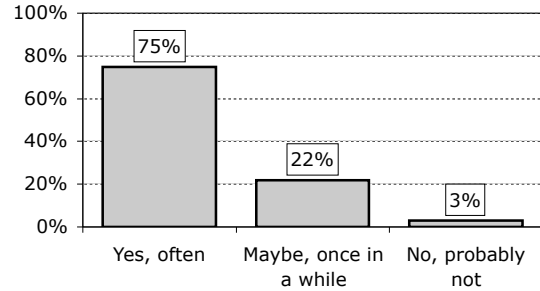
12. In this class, you could use email to communicate with your instructor and other students in the class. As a result, did you get in touch with your instructor and classmates more often than you might in a class without email?

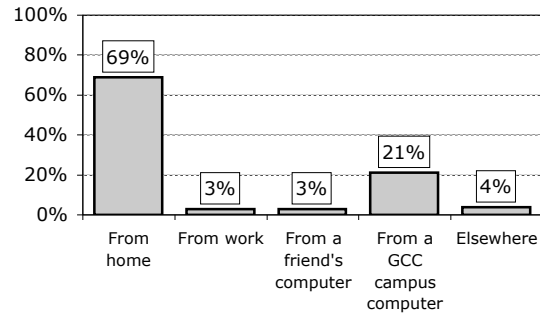
13. If you could access this website for your next English class, would you use it to practice your grammar and composition skills?

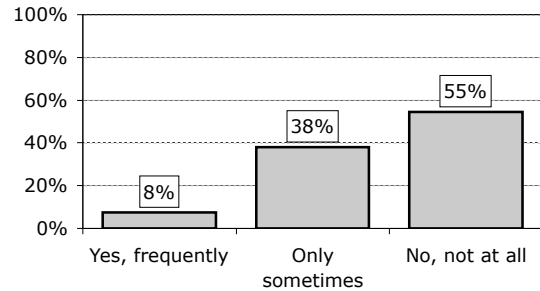
14. Outside of class, where did you access the class website most often?

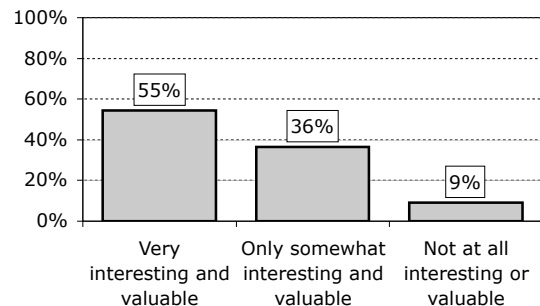
15. Outside of class, was accessing the class website ever a problem?
