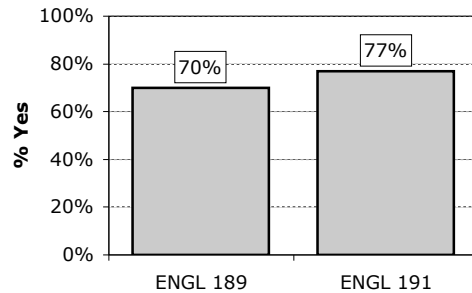

Comparison of Responses from English 189 and 191**

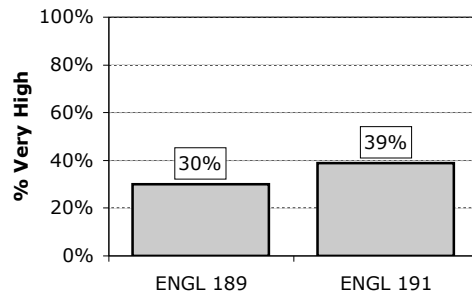
**Is this the first class in which you have used a course website?**

No	30%	23%



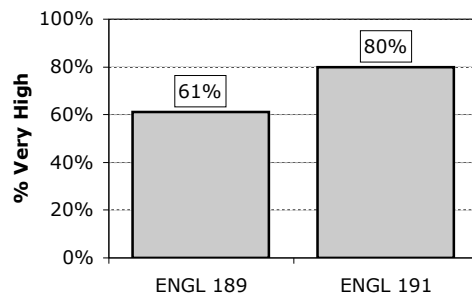
**When you entered this class, what was your comfort/skill level with using a computer?**

None	1%	1%



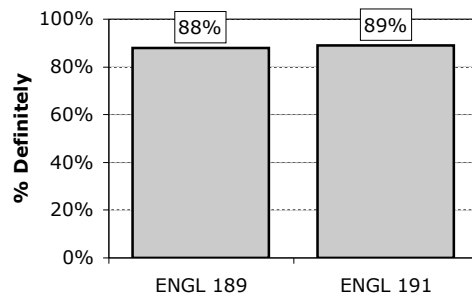
**After completing this course, what is your comfort/skill level in using a computer?**

None	0%	0%



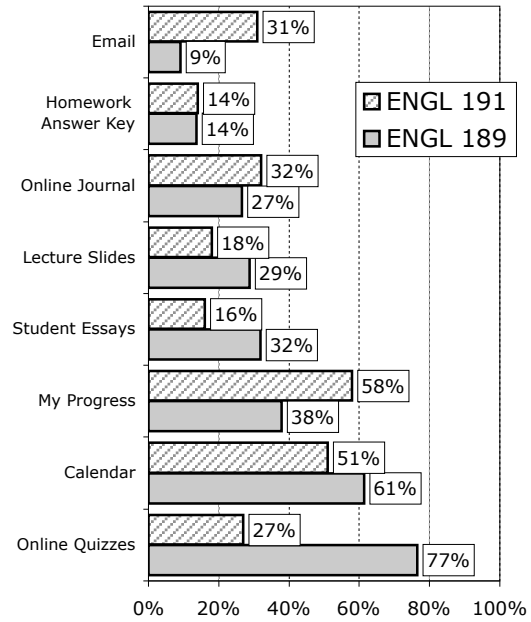
**In the future, will you feel more secure if you take a class that uses a course website?**

No, not at all	3%	0%



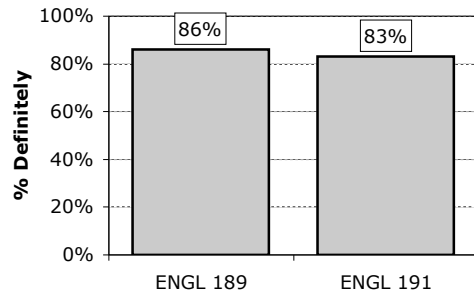
**Which three features of the class website did you like the most?**

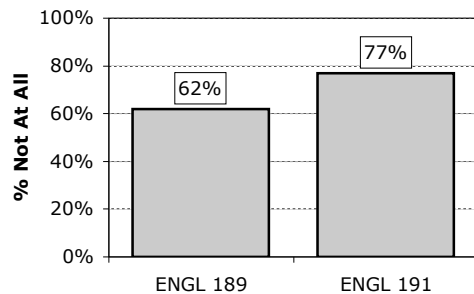
**Did the technology help you learn the course materials better?**

No, not really	2%	3%



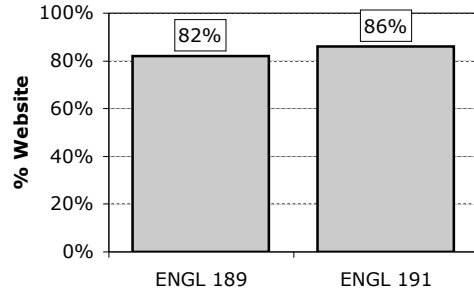
**Did using computer/web technology in the course ever put you at a disadvantage?**

Not at all	62%	77%



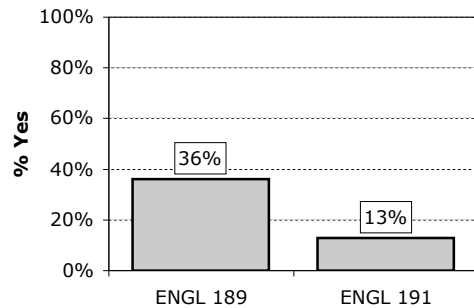
**Did you prefer doing exercises in the textbook or on the website?**

On the website	82%	86%



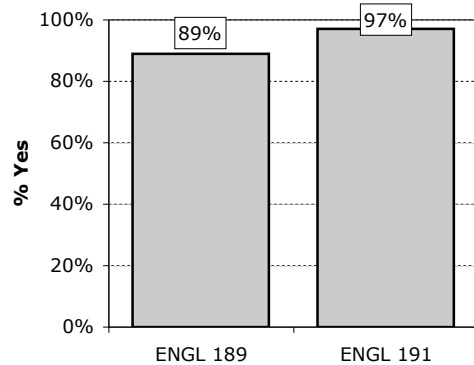
**With all the materials on the website, do you feel the class still needs a textbook?**

No, the textbook is not necessary	23%	59%



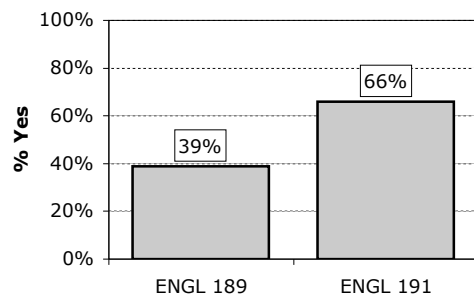
**Do you think the slide presentations were more effective than writing on a chalkboard or whiteboard?**

No, writing on a chalkboard or whiteboard is more effective than the slide presentations	0%	1%



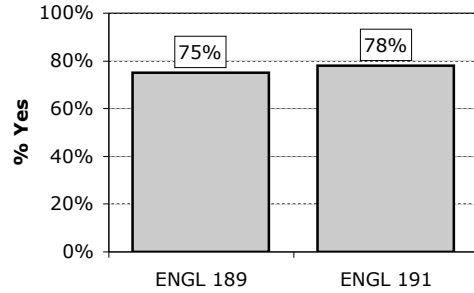
**In this class, you could use email to communicate with your instructor and other students in the class. As a result, did you get in touch with your instructor and classmates more often than you might in a class without email?**

No, not really	30%	13%



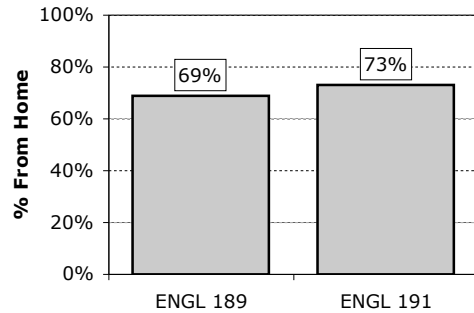
**If you could access this website for your next English class, would you use it to practice your grammar and composition skills?**

No, not really	3%	1%



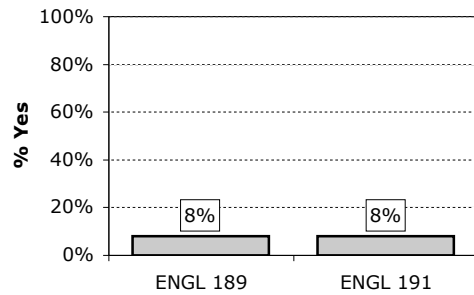
**Outside of class, where did you access the class website most often?**
