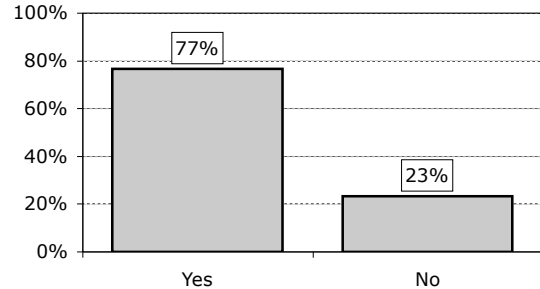

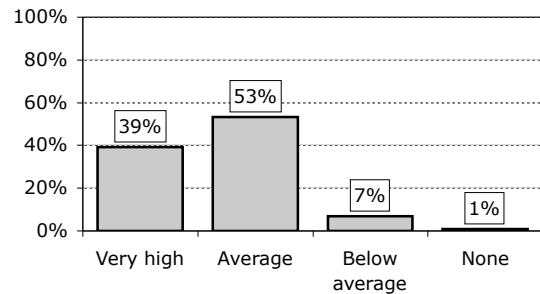
1. Is this the first class in which you have used a course website?

Valid Responses	133	100%



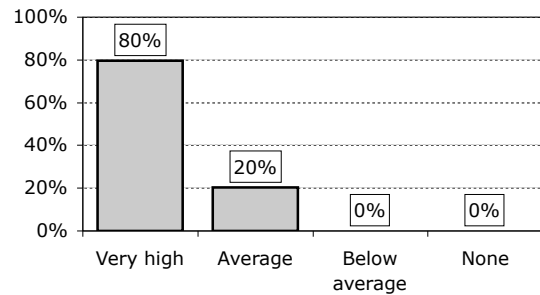
2. When you entered this class, what was your comfort/skill level with using a computer?

3. After completing this course, what is your comfort/skill level in using a computer?

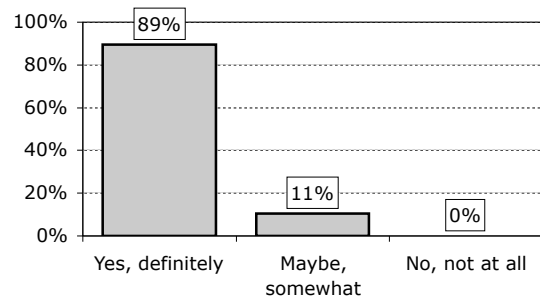

Note: Of the 133 students responding to both questions 2 and 3, 59 (or 44%) reported an increase in their comfort/skill level in using a computer.

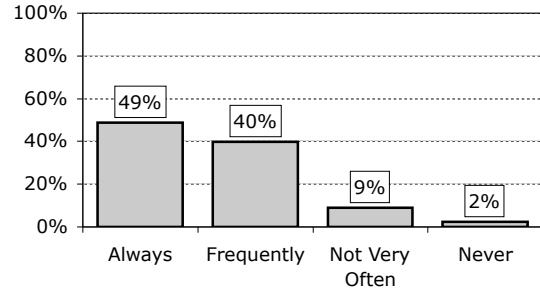
4. In the future, will you feel more secure if you take a class that uses a course website?

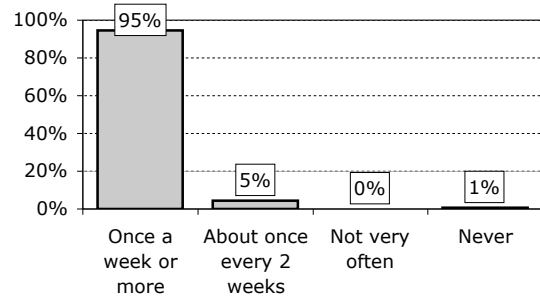
5. If you could redesign this course, how often would you like to be in the computer lab?

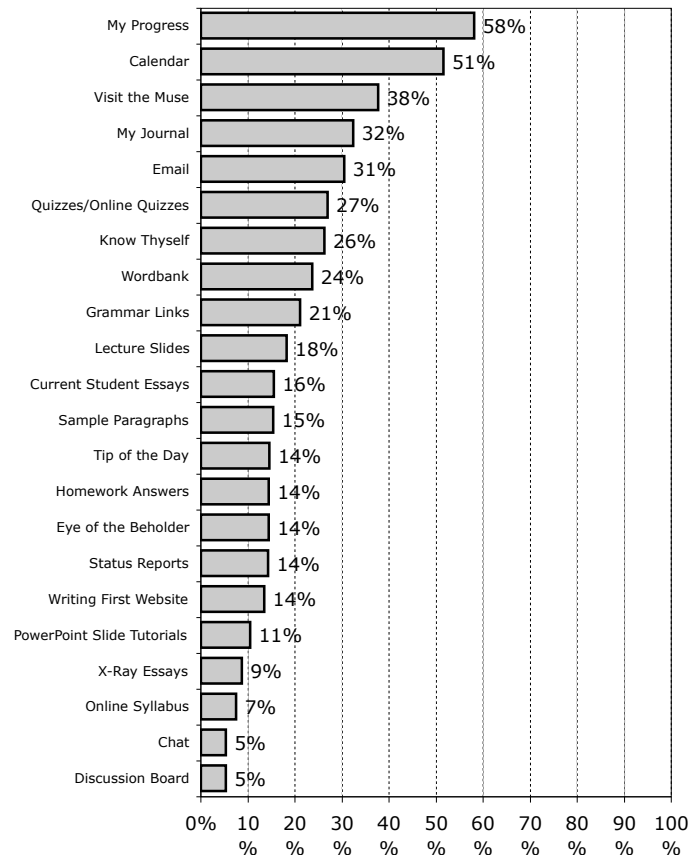
6. How often did you visit the website outside of class?

7. Which three features of the class website did you like the most?

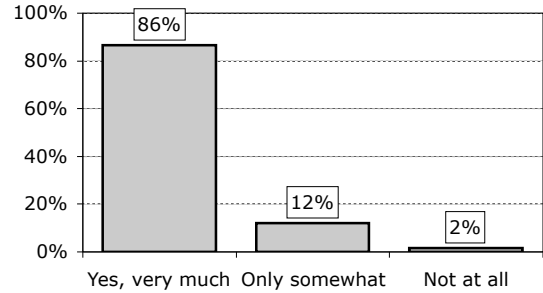

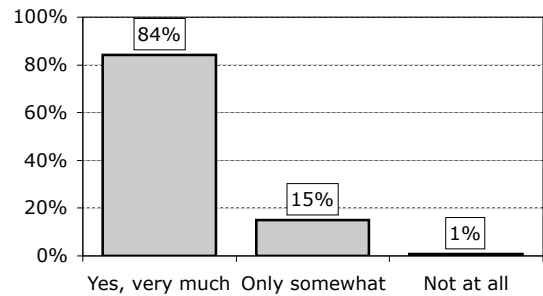
8. Did the technology help you learn the course materials better?

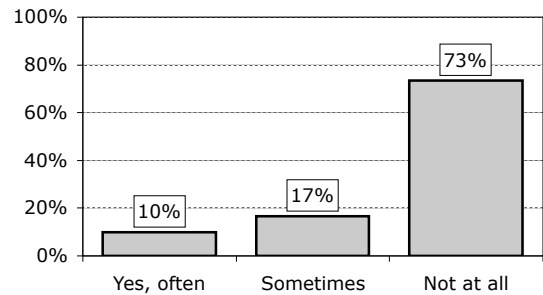
9. Did using the computer help class time pass more quickly?

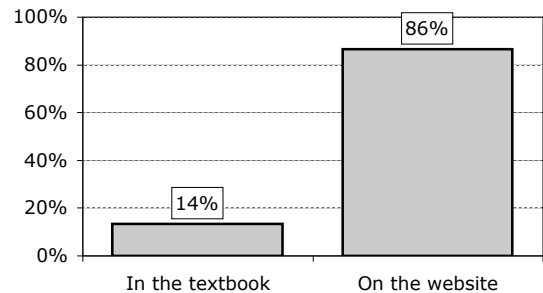
10. Did the technology ever interfere with your ability to learn the course materials?

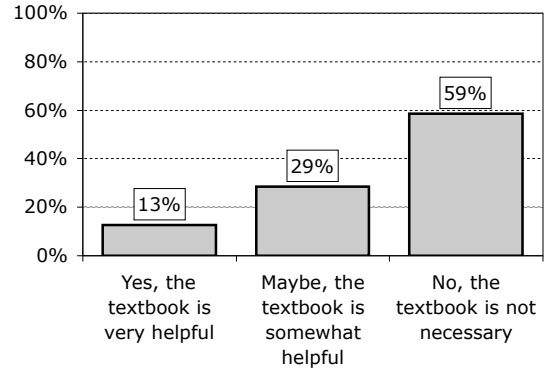
11. Did you prefer doing exercises (grammar and composition) in the textbook or on the website?

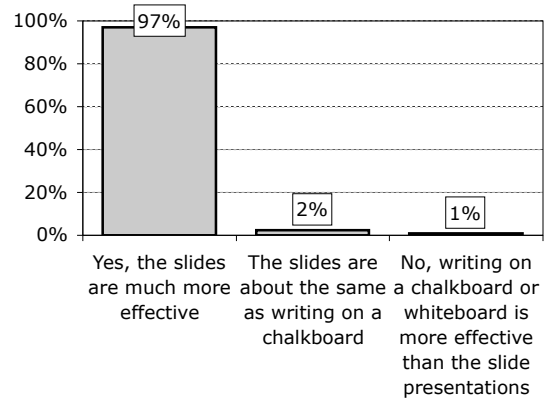
12. With all the materials on the website, do you feel the class still needs a textbook?

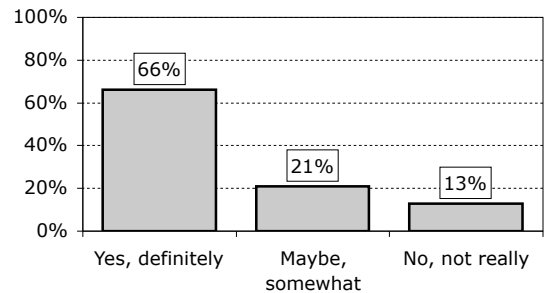
13. Do you think the slide presentations were more effective than writing on a chalkboard or whiteboard?

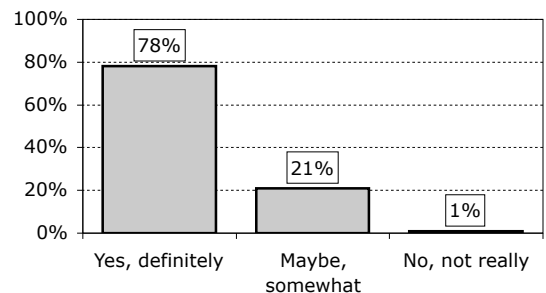
14. In this class, you could use email to communicate with your instructor and other students in the class. As a result, did you get in touch with your instructor and classmates more often than you might in a class without email?

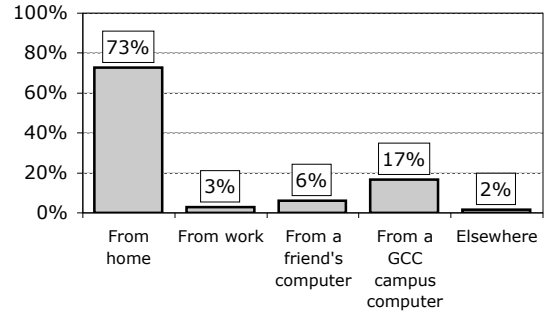
15. If you could access this website for your next English class, would you use it to practice your grammar and composition skills?

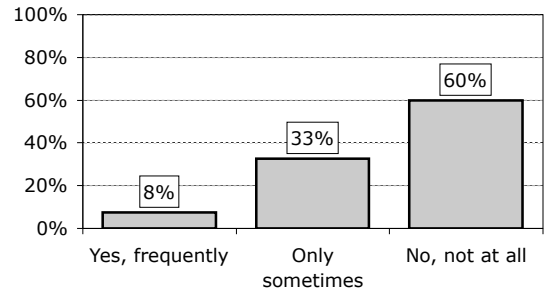
16. Outside of class, where did you access the class website most often?

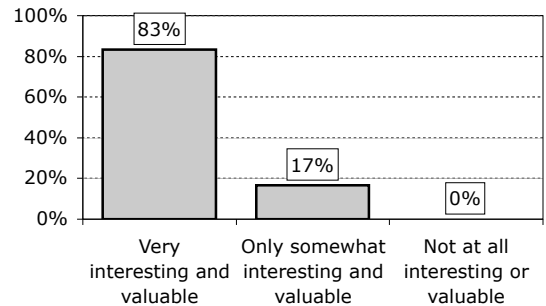
17. Outside of class, was accessing the class website ever a problem?

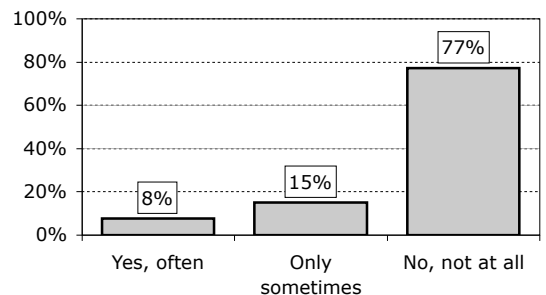
18. In the class, you used Internet sites such as (list of sites) to prepare for your essay writing. How interesting and valuable do you consider the research you did on these sites?
